## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read 2 3 as follows: 4 "CHAPTER HAWAII HEALTH AUTHORITY 5 -1 Hawaii health authority; establishment. (a) 6 There is established within the department of budget and finance for 7 administrative purposes the Hawaii health authority. 8 authority shall be an autonomous public body corporate and 9 politic and an instrumentality of the State. 10 11 The authority shall be composed of nine members (b) 12 appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34; provided 13 that three members shall be appointed from a list of nominees 14 submitted by the speaker of the house of representatives and three members shall be appointed from a list of nominees 15 submitted by the president of the senate. All members shall be 16

appointed for terms of four years each.

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- 1 (c) An executive director shall be selected by the
- 2 members.
- 3 (d) Each member shall hold office until the member's
- 4 successor is appointed and qualified.
- 5 (e) Five members shall constitute a quorum, whose
- 6 affirmative vote shall be necessary for all valid actions by the
- 7 authority.
- 9 responsibilities. (a) The authority shall be responsible for
- 10 overall health planning for the State and shall be responsible
- 11 for determining future capacity needs of health providers,
- 12 facilities, equipment, and support services providers.
- 13 (b) The authority shall develop a comprehensive health
- 14 plan that includes:
- 15 (1) Establishment of eligibility for inclusion in a health
- plan for all individuals;
- 17 (2) Establishment of all reimbursable services to be paid
- by the authority;
- 19 (3) Establishment of all approved providers of services in
- a health plan for all individuals;
- 21 (4) Evaluation of health care and cost effectiveness of
- all aspects of a health plan for all individuals;

- (5) Establishment of a budget for a health plan for all
  individuals in the State.
- 3 (c) The authority may seek waivers of federal law, rule,
- 4 or regulation necessary to implement and maintain the provisions
- 5 of this chapter.
- 6 (d) The authority shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
- 7 necessary for the purposes of this chapter.
- **8** (e) The authority shall submit a comprehensive health plan
- 9 for all individuals in the State, including its findings and
- 10 recommendations, to the legislature no later than twenty days
- 11 before the convening of the regular session of 2008."
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 15 purpose of operating the Hawaii health authority.
- 16 The sum shall be expended by the department of budget and
- 17 finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
- 19 except that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
