A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TEACHER CADET PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii continues to 2 have a critical shortage of trained teachers for the public 3 school system. In order to address the teacher shortage, members of the Hawaii Alliance for Future Teachers initiated the 4 5 teacher cadet program, which began in the 2004-2005 school year with the participation of the Kamehameha Schools and five public 6 7 schools: Campbell, Farrington, Kaimuki, and Kapolei high schools, and Kahuku intermediate and high school. The program 8 9 is modeled after a program in South Carolina that has been **10** successful for the past twenty years in educating high school 11 students in teaching, monitoring them in college, and obtaining jobs for students in the public school system. 12 13 The Hawaii program was developed to be a year-long elective 14 course aimed at high school seniors. The program is targeted 15 for students who are specifically interested in exploring 16 education as a career option. The program provides students with information, field experiences, and insights into teaching 17
- 18 in Hawaii schools, and guides and supports Hawaii's future



- 1 teachers to ensure success in their chosen profession.
- 2 Participants also benefit from adult mentors who help them with
- 3 college applications and financial planning.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to encourage and support high
- 5 school students who want to make a career of teaching in Hawaii
- 6 public schools.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 10 operations of the teacher cadet program, which shall include
- 11 recruitment, retention, training, and teacher support.
- 12 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be deposited into
- 13 the Hawaii teacher cadet program fund for the purposes of this
- 14 Act, provided that during fiscal year 2006-2007 the Hawaii
- 15 Alliance for Future Teachers shall match the amount as provided
- 16 in section 302A-401.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
