## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE INVERTEBRATES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 188, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§188- Commercial taking of certain female marine
5	invertebrates prohibited. (a) Commercial taking, or offering
6	for sale, of female ula (spiny lobster), Kona crab, and Samoan
7	<pre>crab is prohibited.</pre>
8	(b) This section shall not be construed to prohibit sale
9	of the female marine invertebrates identified in subsection (a)
10	if they are the product of commercial aquaculture and not taken
11	for sale from their natural environment."

- 12 SECTION 2. This Act shall take precedence over any
- 13 contrary rule adopted by the department of land and natural
- 14 resources pursuant to chapter 91.
- 15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
