A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. After extensive deliberation, the interagency			
2	working group, which was established pursuant to part VIII of			
3	Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, the Reinventing Education			
4	Act of 2004, has recommended that the transfer of functions from			
5	the department of human services to the department of education			
6	relating to employment background checks be repealed.			
7	SECTION 2. Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is amended			
8	by amending sections 47 and 48 to read as follows:			
9	"SECTION 47. (a) All the rights, powers, functions,			
10	duties, and resources of:			
11	(1) The department of budget and finance relating to the:			
12	(A) Funding of collective bargaining agreement			
13	increases; and			
14	(B) Securing, administering, use, and expending of			
15	federal funds and other aid, including their			
16	custodial supervision;			
17	(2) The department of the attorney general relating to:
