## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules. 4 [Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county shall 5 enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks, except 6 as required in this chapter, that is inconsistent with or more 7 restrictive than, the provisions of this chapter. Any 8 ordinances and rules regulating fireworks that were enacted or 9 adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except those 10 provisions which are not inconsistent with, or more restrictive 11 than those of this chapter, are declared void. A county shall **12** comply with this chapter unless the county council passes an 13 ordinance providing for regulation that is as restrictive or more restrictive than this chapter. If a county passes an 14 15 ordinance that contains less restrictive provisions, these 16 provisions shall be void."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
