A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE OF HAWAII ENDOWMENT FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 to the State of Hawaii endowment fund, which is a separate fund
- 3 of the Honolulu symphony trust. Income and capital gains from
- 4 the fund will be used for the production of music by an Oahu-
- 5 based symphony orchestra as determined by the state foundation
- 6 on culture and the arts.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000, or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, into
- 10 the State of Hawaii endowment fund for the production of music
- 11 by an Oahu-based symphony orchestra to be matched dollar for
- 12 dollar by private funds.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
