A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LIBRARIAN POSITIONS AT WAIALUA LIBRARY AND KAHUKU PUBLIC SCHOOL LIBRARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that currently at both
- 2 Waialua library and Kahuku public school library there are two
- 3 half-time children's librarian positions. The legislature
- 4 further finds that the current situations at these libraries
- 5 necessitate the establishment of two full-time children's
- 6 librarian positions with full benefits. The purpose of this Act
- 7 is to create and fund two full-time children's librarian
- 8 positions at Waialua library and Kahuku public school library.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$43,276.80, or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 12 the establishment one full-time librarian III position (1.00
- 13 FTE) at the Waialua library, and one full-time librarian III
- 14 position (1.00 FTE) at the Kahuku public school library.
- 15 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 16 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
