A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LIBRARIAN POSITIONS AT WAIALUA LIBRARY AND KAHUKU PUBLIC SCHOOL LIBRARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Waialua library
- 2 and the Kahuku public school library each have one half-time
- 3 children's librarian position. The legislature further finds
- 4 that the current situation at these libraries necessitates the
- 5 establishment of a full-time children's librarian position with
- 6 full benefits at each library.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to create and fund two full-time
- 8 children's librarian positions, one for the Waialua library and
- 9 the other for the Kahuku public school library.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 13 the establishment of one full-time librarian III position (1.00
- 14 FTE) at the Waialua library, and one full-time librarian III
- 15 position (1.00 FTE) at the Kahuku public school library.
- 16 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 17 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
