BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 662, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§662- Defense of Highway Design. In any action wherein
- 5 a plaintiff alleges that the plaintiff was damaged by the
- 6 negligent, defective, or dangerous design or maintenance of a
- 7 highway or road, the State and its political subdivisions shall
- 8 be entitled to a defense which shall be a complete bar to
- 9 recovery when the State or its political subdivisions can prove
- 10 by a preponderance of the evidence that the alleged negligent,
- 11 defective, or dangerous design or maintenance reasonably
- 12 complied with highway and road design or maintenance standards
- 13 generally accepted at the time the highway or road was designed
- 14 or constructed."
