A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE TORT LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 662, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

3 and to read as follows:

4 "§662- Defense of Traffic Control Devices. The State and

5 its political subdivisions shall not be liable under this

6 chapter for an injury caused by the failure to provide traffic

7 or warning signals, signs, markings, or devices. Nothing in

8 this section exonerates the State or its political subdivisions

9 from liability for injury proximately caused by such failure if

a signal, sign, marking, or device was necessary to warn of a

11 dangerous condition which endangered the safe movement of

12 traffic and which would not be reasonably apparent to, and would

13 not have been anticipated by, a person exercising due care."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
