A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a number of local
2	and national studies have recognized substantial differences
3	between students within a grade in terms of their performance
4	and ability based on their birthdates. Younger students born
5	between July and December are at greatest risk for a variety of
6	learning difficulties. To create conditions that will enable
7	children in Hawaii to succeed in kindergarten and later grades,
8	the legislature enacted Act 219, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, to
9	implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum by
10	establishing a two-tier junior kindergarten and kindergarten.
11	The purpose of this Act is to assist in implementing Act
12	219, by appropriating funds to provide additional teacher and
13	educational assistant positions for junior kindergarten and
14	kindergarten classes and to conduct a longitudinal study to
15	evaluate the pilot program and follow children from kindergarten
16	to grade three to find implications and correlation to student
17	achievement that are attributable to the establishment of junior
18	kindergarten and kindergarten with a more targeted
