A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 1 education established a federal revenue maximization program to 2 3 develop a process to recover reimbursement for all 4 medicaid-eligible health services that the department provides 5 to Hawaii's school-aged children. 6 The legislature also finds that moneys generated from the 7 revenue maximization program are deposited into the general 8 However, the deposit of generated revenue into the 9 general fund does not guarantee that the moneys are dedicated to 10 the school-based federal revenue maximization program. 11 establishment of a revolving fund for the federal revenue 12 maximization program is necessary to provide a clear nexus 13 between the revenue generated from the school-based claiming 14 program and the provision of those services.

The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support the administration and operations of the federal revenue

maximization program.
