BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 1 education established a federal revenue maximization program to 2 develop a process to recover reimbursement for all 3 medicaid-eligible health services that the department provides 4 to Hawaii's school-aged children. 5 The legislature also finds that moneys generated from the 6 revenue maximization program are deposited into the general 7 However, the deposit of generated revenue into the 8 general fund does not guarantee that the moneys are dedicated to 9 the school-based federal revenue maximization program. 10 establishment of a revolving fund for the federal revenue 11 maximization program is necessary to provide a clear nexus 12 13 between the revenue generated from the school-based claiming

The purpose of this Act is to create a revenue source for 15 medicaid-eligible health services provided by the department of 16 education by establishing a revolving fund for the collection **17** and disbursement of generated revenue to support the 18
