BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the importance of 1
- junior kindergarten, kindergarten, Head Start, preschool and 2
- 3 other early education programs offered by public, nonprofit, and
- private entities. The purpose of this Act is to support early 4
- 5 education by encouraging potential uses of vacant classrooms as
- 6 possible early education facilities.
- 7 SECTION 2. The department of education shall aggressively
- seek or request proposals from public, nonprofit, and private 8
- agencies to use the department's available vacant classrooms for 9
- 10 early education programs.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much 12
- thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for 13
- providing facilities for early education programs. 14
- SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the 15
- department of education for the purposes of this Act. 16
