A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the importance of
- 2 junior kindergarten, kindergarten, Head Start, preschool, and
- 3 other early education programs offered by public, nonprofit, and
- 4 private entities. The purpose of this Act is to support early
- 5 education by encouraging the use of vacant classrooms as
- 6 potential early education facilities.
- 7 SECTION 2. The department of education shall aggressively
- 8 seek or request proposals from public, nonprofit, and private
- 9 agencies to use the department's available vacant classrooms for
- 10 early education programs.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 14 providing facilities for early education programs.
- 15 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 16 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
