## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELAND SECURITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from grants from the	
2	United St	ates Office for Domestic Preparedness and State
3	Homeland	Security Program the sum of \$45,000,000 or so much
4	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for:
5	(1)	An assessment of the threat of terrorist incidents;
6	(2)	The development of plans to deal with terrorist
7		incidents;
8	(3)	Training and exercises to implement such plans;
9	(4)	The procurement of equipment, materials, and supplies
10		essential to meet the potential threats of
11		conventional, chemical, biological, radiological, and
12		nuclear weapons.
13	SECTION 2. The department of defense shall submit to the	
14	legislature for approval a homeland security plan consistent	
15	with policies established by the legislature for homeland	
16	security.	

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
