A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that community

 involvement is one of the most important means of improving

 ducational outcomes and public confidence in schools. Pursuant
- 4 to part V of Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, school
- 5 community councils were established as the mechanism for
- 6 parents, the community, and other key stakeholders to have a
- 7 voice in the affairs of their local schools.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide funds for training
- 9 and other support for the school community councils.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 13 training and support for the school community councils.
- 14 SECTION 3. The department of education and the board of
- 15 education shall work with the school community councils to
- 16 propose an entity to conduct future training and provide support
- 17 for the school community councils.

- 1 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 2 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
