A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii P-20 Initiative, housed within the
- 2 University of Hawaii system, is a statewide collaboration to
- 3 improve student achievement. P-20 is the code for learning that
- 4 connects all levels of education and infuses them with a strong
- 5 sense of coherence. The initiative focuses on the learner
- 6 rather than the system through which the learner is passing.
- 7 The Hawaii P-20 Initiative is a collaboration involving the
- 8 University of Hawaii, the department of education, community
- 9 organizations, labor, business, and many community partners in
- 10 the private and not-for-profit sectors.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to assist the department of
- 12 education and the University of Hawaii with their joint efforts
- 13 to gather data about student learning and make the data
- 14 accessible to Hawaii's education community.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$510,000, or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 18 operating expenses that include personnel and infrastructure to

- 1 support the linking and follow-through of databases, data
- 2 collection support, and the purchase of secondary data sets.
- 3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 4 University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
