A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- "\$128- Disaster preparedness; emergency shelters. (a) 4
- The director, in consultation with the department of civil 5
- defense for each county and the appropriate state agencies, 6
- 7 shall develop a disaster preparedness emergency shelter plan
- 8 that provides adequate emergency shelter for all residents and
- 9 visitors.
- The disaster preparedness emergency shelter plan shall 10
- include a list of facilities currently designated as emergency 11
- 12 public shelters, indicating whether the shelters meet public
- shelter design criteria standards established pursuant to Act 5, 13
- 14 Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005. If a currently designated
- emergency public shelter does not meet these standards, the 15
- 16 director, in consultation with the department of education or
- 17 the department of accounting and general services, as
- appropriate, shall develop and implement a plan to retrofit the 18

- 1 shelter to comply with the public shelter design criteria
 2 standards.
- (c) The plan also shall identify sites for new emergency
- 4 public shelters and provide a schedule for the creation of the
- 5 new emergency public shelters necessary to meet the anticipated
- 6 needs of both residents and visitors during any natural or man-
- 7 made disaster; provided that any newly designated or created
- 8 emergency public shelter shall meet the public shelter design
- 9 criteria standards established pursuant to Act 5, Special
- 10 Session Laws of Hawaii 2005."
- 11 SECTION 2. The director of civil defense shall submit to
- 12 the legislature no less than twenty days prior to the opening of
- 13 the regular session of 2007 a report concerning the disaster
- 14 preparedness emergency public shelter plan, which includes the
- 15 status of currently designated emergency public shelters and
- 16 their compliance with the design criteria established pursuant
- 17 to Act 5, Special Session Laws of 2005, a timetable for the
- 18 creation of new emergency public shelters to meet the
- 19 anticipated needs of visitors and residents.
- 20 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 22 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for

- 1 the disaster preparedness emergency public shelter plan, which
- 2 shall be used for the planning, design, construction, and
- 3 equipment costs related to the retrofitting of existing
- 4 emergency public shelters and the construction of new emergency
- 5 public shelters that comply with established public shelter
- 6 design criteria standards, pursuant to Act 5, Special Session
- 7 Laws of Hawaii 2005.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon approval;
- 12 provided that section 4 shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
