A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRICIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 448E-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "\$448E-1 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless 3 4 otherwise indicated by the context: 5 "Board" means the board of electricians and plumbers. "Electrical work" means all electrical wiring and work 6 7 related to the distribution and operation of electrical energy in the State regardless of the location of this work, within the 8 9 scope and purpose of the National Electrical Code, unless 10 preempted by state law. 11 "Journey worker electrician" means any person who has been 12 licensed by the board as a journey worker electrician to perform 13 and direct all phases of electrical work[-], including 14 industrial, specialty, and maintenance work related to the 15 installation, repair, alteration, and maintenance of any

electrical systems within the scope and purpose of the National

1 control, other than a control for a single family or two family 2 dwelling; and low voltage communication signal systems.] the 3 installation, repair, alteration, and maintenance of low voltage 4 systems that operate at fifty volts or less, but shall not 5 include such a person performing and directing the attachment of 6 lighting or power circuits, or the installation of raceways. 7 "Maintenance electrician" means any person who has been 8 licensed by the board as a maintenance electrician to [maintain 9 electrical perform electrical maintenance work. 10 "Master plumber" means any person who has been licensed by 11 the board as a master plumber to direct and supervise the 12 performance of plumbing work and to perform plumbing work and 13 who provides overall supervision and general direction and is responsible for proper installation of plumbing work. 14 15 "Supervising electrician" means any person who has been 16 licensed by the board as a supervising electrician to perform, 17 direct, and supervise the performance of electrical work [and to 18 perform electrical work.] including industrial, specialty, and 19 maintenance work related to the installation, repair, 20 alteration, and maintenance of any electrical systems within the 21 scope and purpose of the National Electrical Code.

1 general direction and shall be responsible for the proper 2 installation of electrical work. 3 "Supervising industrial electrician" means any person who 4 has been licensed by the board as a supervising industrial 5 electrician to perform, direct, maintain, and supervise the 6 performance of electrical work related to substation, 7 switchgear, automatic controls, and all other industrial 8 electrical work in existing industrial buildings and work 9 places [-], except work to install raceways. The supervising industrial electrician shall provide overall supervision and 10 11 general direction and shall be responsible for the proper 12 installation of electrical work. "Supervising specialty electrician" means any person who 13 14 has been licensed by the board as a supervising specialty 15 electrician to perform, direct, and supervise the performance of 16 electrical work related to [installing, repairing, altering, and 17 maintaining, but not the attachment of lighting and power 18 circuits, to the following: electronic equipment, sound public 19 address systems, other than equipment and systems for a single-20 family or two family dwelling; master or community radio and 21 television receiving antenna system; sound recording systems 22 other than systems for a single-family or a two-family dwelling;

2	other than control for a single family or two family dwelling;
3	and low voltage communication signal systems.] the installation,
