A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to specify that half of the electrical and plumbing workers employed by an electrical 2 or plumbing contractor on a construction job site shall be 3 licensed in accordance with chapter 448E, rather than half of 4 5 all craftsmen requiring licenses. SECTION 2. Section 444-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 6 7 amended to read as follows: "[+] §444-9.5[+] Licensing of craftsmen. At least half of 8 9 all [craftsmen requiring licenses] individuals performing 10 electrical or plumbing work requiring licenses under chapter 448E employed on a construction [project] job site by [a 11 specialty] an electrical or plumbing contractor [in the trade in 12 13 which the craftsman is licensed | shall be licensed in accordance 14 with [and to the extent required by] chapter 448E. The board 15 may waive this requirement in any county when there are 16 insufficient licensed [eraftsmen] electrical or plumbing workers

in that county to comply herewith."
