A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE COURTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the					
2	circuit and district courts to be open for extended hours to,					
3	among other things, process arrest warrants and ease the burden					
4	on the State's jails by allowing persons to be arraigned shortly					
5	after their arrest.					
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 603, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is					
7	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated					
8	and to read as follows:					
9	" <u>\$603-</u> Extended court hours. (a) Effective January 1,					
10	2007, the circuit courts shall be required to be open to conduct					
11	judicial business during the following extended hours:					
12	(1) The first judicial circuit shall be open:					
13	(A) Six o'clock p.m. to 12:00 midnight, Monday					
14	through Friday, excluding state holidays as					
15	designated in section 8-1; and					
16	(B) Nine o'clock a.m. to four o'clock p.m. on					
17	Saturdays.					

1	(2)	(2) The circuit courts of the second, third, and fifth			
2	circuits shall be open:				
3	(A) Six o'clock p.m. to 12:00 midnight at least three				
4			days per week, excluding state holidays as		
5			designated in section 8-1; and		
6		(B)	Nine o'clock a.m. to four o'clock p.m. on		
7			Saturdays.		
8	(b) During the extended court hours, the circuit courts				
9	shall process arrest warrants and conduct any other business				
10	deemed necessary."				
11	SECTION 3. Chapter 604, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
12	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
13	and to read as follows:				
14	"§604- Extended court hours. (a) Effective January 1,				
15	2007, the district courts shall be open to conduct judicial				
16	business during the following extended hours:
