## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 58, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended 1 by Act 22, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended by amending 2 section 14 to read as follows: 3 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect [on] upon its 4 5 approval; provided that: The amendments made to sections 40-1, 40-4, and 40-6, (1)6 Hawaii Revised Statutes, by part I of this Act shall 7 not be repealed when those sections are reenacted on June 30, 2005, by section 24 of Act 115, Session Laws 9 of Hawaii 1998; 10 (2) Part I shall be repealed on June 30, 2007, and 11 sections 28-8.3, 201B-2, and 201B-11, Hawaii Revised 12 Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which they 13 read on May 5, 2004, and sections 40-1, 40-4, and 14 15 40-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which they read on June 30, 1986; ] and 16  $[\frac{(3)}{2}]$  (2) Section 9 shall take effect July 1, 2004." 17
