A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A procurement exemption for the natural energy 2 laboratory of Hawaii (NELHA) would make it more efficient in its 3 procurement process and enable it to attract more competent 4 service providers. Because NELHA is a unique agency that deals 5 with various cutting edge technology projects, it is sometimes 6 not practical for NELHA to go through the procurement code 7 process to select the best services from competent contractors 8 without long delays. Federal funds earmarked to NELHA are very 9 difficult to pass through to contracted agencies under 10 procurement code procedures. Allowing NELHA to make 11 procurements without the necessity of going though a bid process 12 would give NELHA the opportunity to work with universities and 13 laboratories conducting research on a continual contract basis, 14 particularly when federal monies are involved. NELHA is subject 15 to periodic federal government audits in connection with the 16 expenditure of federal funds.
- The purpose of this Act is to grant a procurement exemption

 for the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii.



1	SECTION 2. Section 227D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) The authority shall not be subject to [the
4	requirements of chapter] chapters 103 and 103D for project
5	agreements, construction contracts, retail concession or
6	tour-related contracts, or other contracts unless a project
7	agreement with respect to a project or research and technology
8	park shall require otherwise."
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
