A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that the Hawaii civil 2 rights commission currently carries a caseload of 360 complaints 3 under investigation, with 370-450 new complaints filed annually. 4 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii civil rights commission has taken steps to reduce the length of time 5 6 necessary for the completion of the investigation of a complaint 7 from three years to two years, and eventually to eighteen 8 The Hawaii civil rights commission staffs four enforcement attorneys, each assigned an average of twenty-five 9 10 Efforts to handle this caseload have been hampered in 11 the recent past due to the termination of all student 12 employment. A successful program implemented by the Hawaii 13 civil rights commission, the voluntary mediation program, also 14 has been hindered due to a lack of support.
- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for three positions: an investigator, a legal assistant, and an attorney
- 17 mediation coordinator, in order to provide necessary support to
- 18 the Hawaii civil rights commission.



- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$134,340, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 4 establishment of one full-time investigator IV position (1.00
- 5 FTE), one full-time legal assistant position (1.00 FTE), and one
- $\mathbf{6}$ attorney mediation coordinator (1.00 FTE) at the Hawaii civil
- 7 rights commission.
- 8 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 9 department of labor and industrial relations for the purposes of
- 10 this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
