BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-205, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§103D-205 Authority and duties of the chief procurement (a) For their respective jurisdictions and unless 4 officer. 5 otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, each chief procurement officer shall serve as the central procurement 6 officer and: 7 8 (1) Procure or supervise the procurement of all goods, 9 services, and construction; 10 (2) Exercise general supervision and control over all 11 inventories of goods; 12 (3) Sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of surplus goods; 13 and 14 Establish and maintain programs for the inspection, (4)15 testing, and acceptance of goods, services, and 16 construction. 17 (b) Consistent with the provisions of this chapter and
- 18 rules adopted by the policy board to implement its provisions,

- 1 the chief procurement officers may adopt operational procedures
- 2 to assist in the performance of these duties and
- 3 responsibilities.
- 4 (c) It shall be the responsibility of the chief
- 5 procurement officer to inform every governmental contracting
- 6 agency that the requirements of chapter 104 are applicable for
- 7 every contract for construction of a public work in excess of
- 8 \$2,000, including emergency contracts and contracts funded by
- 9 special purpose revenue bonds, purchase orders, and vouchers."

- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
