## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ONE CALL CENTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 269E-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"[+]§269E-4[+] One call center advisory committee.
4	[+](a)[+] The commission shall establish a one call center
5	advisory committee as a governmental entity as defined under
6	chapter 662D to advise the commission in implementing this
7	chapter. The committee shall consist of [fifteen] seventeen
8	voting members and one ex officio nonvoting member. Of the
9	voting members:
10	(1) [Nine] Eleven shall be appointed by the commission to
11	serve until successors are appointed by the
12	commission. The appointments shall be as follows:
13	(A) One from the gas utility industry;
14	(B) One from the electric utility industry;
15	(C) One from the telecommunications utility industry;
16	(D) One from the pipeline operator industry;
17	(E) Two from the General Contractors Association of
18	Hawaii;

1		(F) Two from the Building Industry Association of
2		Hawaii; [ <del>and</del> ]
3		(G) One from the cable service industry;
4		(H) One from the water utility industry; and
5		(I) One from the wastewater industry.
6	(2)	One shall be the representative of the city and county
7		of Honolulu designated by the mayor of the city and
8		county of Honolulu;
9	(3)	One shall be the representative of the county of
10		Hawaii designated by the mayor of the county of
11		Hawaii;
12	(4)	One shall be the representative of the county of Maui
13		designated by the mayor of the county of Maui;
14	(5)	One shall be the representative of the county of Kauai
15		designated by the mayor of the county of Kauai;
16	(6)	One shall be the director of the state department of
17		transportation, or the director's representative; and
18	(7)	One shall be the executive director of the division of
19		consumer advocacy, department of commerce and consumer
20		affairs, or the executive director's representative.
21	A represe	ntative of the center shall serve as an ex officio
22	nonvoting	member of the committee.

The committee shall advise the commission on: 3 (c) 4 (1)The establishment of rules; (2) The setting of appropriate fees and assessments for 5 the administration and operation of the center; The selection of the center provider; 7 (3) 8 (4)The enforcement of this chapter; and Other aspects regarding the establishment and 9 (5) operation of the center; 10 provided that the committee shall not advise the commission in 11 12 the exercise of the commission's quasi-judicial, adjudicatory functions, or participate in the commission's deliberations. 13 The committee shall be exempt from chapter 92." 14
