A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the down-sizing of
- 2 the sugar and pineapple industries are leaving vast acres of
- 3 arable land, irrigation water, and agricultural infrastructure
- 4 available for new and more diverse agricultural ventures. To
- 5 meet this challenge, the legislature created the agribusiness
- 6 development corporation.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to direct the office of planning
- 8 to create an action plan to:
- 9 (1) Transfer many of the responsibilities of the board of
- agriculture and the department of agriculture to the
- 11 agribusiness development corporation and to the
- department of business, economic development, and
- 13 tourism; and
- 14 (2) Transfer the agribusiness development corporation from
- the department of agriculture to the department of
- 16 business, economic development, and tourism for
- 17 administrative purposes.
