BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 171-30, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 2 3 [The] For the purposes of monetary grants for acquisition of real property pursuant to section 173A-5 and 4 acquisition of real property by the board of land and natural 5 6 resources pursuant to this section, a complete appraisal determining the fair market value of the real property interest 7 shall be reviewed, approved, and accepted by the granting or 8 acquiring state department agency. In addition, an independent 9 appraisal of private property to be acquired by the State may be 10 required by the state department or agency and performed by not 11 more than three disinterested appraisers whose services shall be 12 contracted for by the State, and no land shall be purchased for 13 a sum greater than the highest value fixed by the appraiser or 14 appraisals; provided that the State, after review of the 15 appraisals by the appraiser or appraisers or the attorney 16 general, may purchase the property at a value greater than the 17 highest value if the higher value is determined by the appraiser 18

- 1 or appraisers or the attorney general to be justified and within
- 2 the range of market value; provided further that this limitation
- 3 shall not apply where acquisition is by condemnation. After the
- 4 private property has been acquired or the State abandons the
- 5 acquisition, these appraisal reports shall be available for
- 6 inspection and copying by the public."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
