A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$52,130,000, or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4	thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5	2006-2007 for the following capital improvements in the second
6	senatorial district:
7	1. Keaau Middle School \$10,185,000
8	Design, construction, and equipment for
9	an eight-classroom building.
10	2. Naalehu Elementary and Intermediate School \$10,215,000
11	Design, construction, and equipment
12	for a new administration/library
13	building and to renovate existing

11	(2) The sum appropriated in item 4 shall be expended by		
12	the department of land and natural resources.		
13	SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital		
14	improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at		
15	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is		
16	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation		
17	unencumbered as of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.		
18	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
