A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2
- 3 The University of Hawaii shall be headed by an
- executive board to be known as the board of regents. 4
- The board shall consist of [twelve] fifteen members. [No 5
- more than six of the members shall be members of the same 6
- political party and at least part of the membership of the board 7
- shall represent geographic subdivisions of the State.] At least 8
- one member shall be a University of Hawaii student at the time 9
- of the initial appointment. This member may be reappointed for 10
- one additional term even though the member may no longer be a 11
- student at the time of reappointment. The governor shall reduce 12
- the terms of those initially appointed to each seat on the board 13
- so as to provide, as far as practicable, for the expiration of 14
- three terms each year, excluding the student member. 15
- At least ten members, except for the student member, shall 16
- represent geographic areas as follows: 17
- Two members from the county of Hawaii; 18 (1)

appointment and membership.] Every member may serve beyond the expiration date of the member's term of appointment until the 2 member's successor has been appointed and has [qualified.] been 3 confirmed by the senate in accordance with article X, section 6 4 of the state constitution. Members shall serve no more than two 5 consecutive five-year terms. If a member is to be appointed to 6 a second term of five years, the senate shall consider the 7 question of whether to reconfirm the member at least one hundred 8 twenty days prior to the conclusion of a member's first five-9 10 year term. The board [shall], at its first meeting after June 30, 11 shall elect a chairperson and vice-chairperson, who shall serve 12 until adjournment of its first meeting after June 30 of the next 13 year or thereafter until their successors are appointed and have 14 qualified and whose election shall be immediately certified by 15 the board to the chief election officer. The board shall 16 appoint a secretary, who shall report to the board but not be a 17 member of the board. The president of the university shall act 18 as executive officer of the board. The board shall meet not 19 less often than ten times annually, and may from time to time 20 meet in each of the counties of Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai. 21

Report Title:

UH; Board of Regents

Description:

Changes board of regents (BOR) membership by increasing the number of members from 12 to 15. Requires a certain number of BOR members to represent specific geographic areas. Establishes that BOR members shall serve no more than 2 consecutive 5-year terms. Establishes that if a member is appointed to a second term of 5 years, the senate will consider the question of whether to reconfirm the member at least 120 days prior to the conclusion of the member's first 5-year term. Clarifies that every BOR member may serve beyond the expiration date of the member's term until the member's successor has been appointed and has been confirmed by the senate.
