
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In May 2002, the University of Hawaii gathered
2 major energy and policy stakeholders in Hawaii to convene as the
3 Hawaii Energy Policy Forum. The purpose of the Hawaii Energy
4 Policy Forum was to develop an energy vision for Hawaii through
5 the year 2030 and to formulate strategies consistent with
6 implementing that vision. Accordingly, facilitated discussions
7 were conducted on Hawaii's preferred energy future and the
8 issues and constraints that would be encountered in achieving
9 that preferred future. Incorporating a science- and fact-based
10 approach, policy studies were conducted to provide baseline
11 information and review of various environmental, regulatory,
12 economic, social, and cultural issues relating to Hawaii's
13 energy future.

14 In December 2003, the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum convened a
15 policy summit to provide a community-based forum for review of
16 its work and recommendations. The final report of the summit,
17 "Hawaii at the Crossroads: A Long Term Energy Strategy," sets



1 forth recommended guiding principles and policy options to meet
2 Hawaii's long term energy needs.

3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to
4 reconvene the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum for the purpose of
5 developing an action plan and timeline for the implementation of
6 the vision, concepts, and recommendations of the summit's final
7 report. This will provide a unique opportunity for stakeholders
8 to continue their work from planning to implementation and for
9 further engagement of policy and decision makers and consumers
10 on issues relevant to creating Hawaii's preferred energy future.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000, or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
14 reconvene the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum to:

- 15 (1) Develop a detailed action plan and timeline to
16 implement the recommendations of the Hawaii Energy
17 Policy Forum's final report titled, "Hawaii at the
18 Crossroads: A Long Term Energy Strategy;"
- 19 (2) Develop tangible goals and actions to implement the
20 energy vision and strategy of the Hawaii Energy Policy
21 Forum;



- 1 (3) Develop benchmarks for measuring outcomes of energy
2 implementation strategies;
- 3 (4) Further engage Hawaii's business, government, labor,
4 and community leaders, and integrate them into the
5 policy activities and discussions of the Hawaii Energy
6 Policy Forum;
- 7 (5) Develop greater community and public awareness about
8 Hawaii's energy needs and the goals and activities of
9 the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum; and
- 10 (6) Seek additional funding for statewide implementation
11 of and public education regarding the recommendations
12 and goals of the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum.

13 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
14 Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism for the
15 purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
