A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	Part I.		
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this part is to establish a		
3	weighted student formula conversion program to provide		
4	supplementary funds for schools that are adversely affected by		
5	the weighted student formula established pursuant to Act 51,		
6	Session Laws of Hawaii 2004.		
7	SECTION 2. There is established in the department of		
8	education a weighted student formula conversion program for the		
9	purpose of disbursing funds to qualified public schools that are		
10	adversely affected by the weighted student formula established		
11	pursuant to Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004. The weighted		
12	student formula conversion program shall be administered by the		
13	department of education, which shall create program guidelines;		
14	provided that:		
15	(1) Only schools that experience a reduced level of		
16	funding due to the implementation of the weighted		
17	student formula may apply for program funds;		

1	(2)	Flogram moneys small be used for the pulpose of
2		maximizing student achievement through enhancing
3		educational outcomes noted in Act 51, Session Laws of
4		Hawaii 2004, and shall be expended to support
5		activities as outlined in the school's strategic plan
6		and academic and financial plan; and
7	(3)	A school, at the discretion of the superintendent of
8		education, may receive these moneys for not more than
9		three years beginning with the 2006-2007 school year,
10		provided that the school demonstrates:
11		(A) Adequate yearly progress as defined by the
12		federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001;
13		(B) Sufficient growth or progress toward meeting
14		adequate yearly progress; or
15		(C) Compliance with the department's weighted student
16		formula conversion personnel management plan.
17	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
18	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
19	much ther	eof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
20	support s	chools adversely affected by the conversion to the
21	weighted	student formula.

- 1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 4 the purpose of establishing a weighted student formula
- 5 conversion program in the department of education to provide
- 6 supplementary funds to schools that are adversely affected by
- 7 the weighted student formula established pursuant to Act 51,
- 8 Session Laws of Hawaii 2004.
- 9 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
- 10 department of education for the purposes of this part.
- 11 Part II.
- 12 SECTION 6. The legislature finds that, in addition to
- 13 investing in school facilities, other important needs such as
- 14 textbooks, computers, equipment, supplies, and necessary
- 15 services are not funded adequately. Moreover, teachers often
- 16 use their personal resources to purchase much-needed classroom
- 17 and instructional supplies.
- 18 The purpose of this part is to provide funds to each school
- 19 for equipment, services, and supplies, as well as reimburse
- 20 teachers for instructional and classroom supplies they purchase
- 21 with personal funds.

- 1 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 4 school equipment, supplies, and services. The sum shall be
- 5 allocated to each school based upon the weighted student
- 6 formula.
- 7 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 10 reimbursement of up to \$200 per classroom for teachers' personal
- 11 funds expended for classroom and instructional supplies. The
- 12 department of education may adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 91,
- 13 Hawaii Revised Statutes, as necessary to implement the purposes
- 14 of this section.
- 15 SECTION 9. Sums appropriated under this part shall be in
- 16 addition to any other funds that may be appropriated for the
- 17 same purposes.
- 18 SECTION 10. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
- 19 department of education for the purposes of this part.
- 20 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.

Appropriates funds for a weighted student formula conversion program that provides supplementary allocations to schools adversely affected by the weighted student formula. Appropriates funds for schools in the department of education for equipment, supplies, and services. Reimburses each teacher up to \$200 for money spent on classroom and instructional teaching supplies. (SD2)
