- 11 hold harmless the governmental body, and its officers and
- employees from and against any liability, loss, damage, cost and 12
- expense, including all reasonable attorneys' fees, and all 13
- claims, suits, and demands therefor, arising out of or resulting 14
- from the negligent and other wrongful acts, errors, or omissions 15
- of the person, the persons' employees, officers, agents, or 16
- subcontractors in the performance of their professional 17
