BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: Children with developmental disabilities; 4 "§302**A**− 5 placement flexibility. The department may elect, upon application by a parent, or in the exercise of its own 6 7 discretion, to allow a child with developmental disabilities to 8 remain in an early education program beyond age three in a setting in which children are grouped by developmental age 9 10 rather than by chronological age." SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 11 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
