A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CHORE SERVICE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that our elderly and 2 disabled populations need assistance with household chores, but many residents do not have friends or families to assist them 3 4 with these routine tasks. Chore services programs enable these 5 residents to remain in their homes after they can no longer 6 perform essential housekeeping and related activities, thereby 7 avoiding premature and costly institutionalization. 8 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for 9 chore services programs. 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 11 , or so 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for 13 the purpose of supporting and expanding the chore services 14 program to provide high quality elder care and services to Hawaii's elderly and disabled populations.
