## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY COURT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 571, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 and to read as follows: 3 4 "§571- Kids first program; expansion of program. 5 kids first program shall be expanded to include as a mandatory element, the development of a parenting plan pursuant to section 6 7 571-46.5." 8 SECTION 2. Section 571-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 10 and to read as follows: ""Kids first program" means the mandatory family court 11 12 program for families going through divorce that is designed to 13 help parents understand the effects of separation and divorce on their minor children and to help minor children cope with 14 15 changes in their families." 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so

much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for

- 14 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 15 judiciary for the purposes of this Act.

- 17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
