A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT OF LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The State's long-term care facilities are
- 2 outdated and built to standards that are not resistant to
- 3 hurricanes and other natural disasters. Many of the elderly and
- 4 infirm reside in long-term care facilities, making them
- 5 vulnerable to severe injury or death from a hurricane or other
- 6 natural disaster.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for a
- 8 statewide engineering assessment of long-term care facilities to
- 9 determine to what extent each facility is prepared to withstand
- 10 a hurricane or other natural disaster.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 14 an engineering assessment of every adult residential care home
- 15 (Types I and II), expanded adult residential care home (Types I
- 16 and II), and hospice home to determine:

1	(1) To	what extent each facility is presently capable of
2	wit	chstanding a hurricane or other natural disaster;
3	(2) The	e nature, extent, and costs of renovation or
4	rer	modeling to bring the facility to the desirable
5	lev	vels of structural sufficiency.
6	SECTION	3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
7	department of	f health for the purposes of this Act.
8	SECTION	4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
