A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that payments from the 1 SECTION 1. 2 State for individuals in adult residential care homes have not increased since 1997, although the cost of care has risen. 3 The purpose of this Act is to increase the level of care 4

payment to adult residential home operators to assist with 5 increased care costs.

SECTION 2. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 8

"(c) The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine the rate of payment for domiciliary care provided to recipients eligible either for Federal Supplementary Security Income, or public assistance in accordance with state standards, or both. The director shall provide for level of care payment as follows:

For those adult residential care homes classified as (1) facility type I, licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary homes as defined under section 321-15.9, and adult foster homes as defined under section 321-11.2, the state supplemental payment shall [not

- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 4 the increase in the level of care payments for adult residential
- 5 care homes.
- 6 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 7 department of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
