A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a growing 1 shortage of healthcare professionals in Hawaii, especially on 2 the neighbor islands and in rural areas. The State's rapidly 3 aging population will significantly increase the demand for 4 health care services and long-term care. As the general 5 population ages, so does the health care workforce, exacerbating 6 the growing shortage of providers. In addition, low 8 reimbursement rates, issues related to living and working in remote communities, challenging working conditions, and the cost 9 of medical malpractice insurance continue to create barriers to 10
- Even if people have health insurance, they are often unable to access appropriate care. A fully staffed, well-trained

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The purpose of this Act is to develop and maintain a 1 statewide comprehensive health care workforce map and database 2 3 to: Compile and analyze existing data on the supply and 4 (1)distribution of all health care practitioners, 5 technicians, and other health care workers by 6 specialty and practice location; 7 Develop a plan to collect and systematically update 8 (2) data; and 9 Project and develop a plan to meet future health care 10 (3)11 workforce needs. SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 12 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for 14 15 the state health planning and development agency to develop and maintain a statewide comprehensive health care workforce map and 16 17 database. SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the 18

department of health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
