A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WEED AND SEED STRATEGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The weed and seed strategy is a United States
- 2 Department of Justice initiative that is administered locally by
- 3 the United States Attorney's Office. Initiated in 1992, the
- 4 strategy currently includes more than three hundred sites in two
- 5 hundred twenty-six cities across the country.
- 6 The weed and seed strategy is a collaborative effort among
- 7 law enforcement (federal, state, and county) agencies, social
- 8 service agencies, private businesses, nonprofit organizations,
- 9 and residents to reclaim, restore, and rebuild communities. The
- 10 four key elements of the weed and seed strategy are:
- 11 (1) Law enforcement;
- 12 (2) Community policing;
- 13 (3) Prevention, intervention, and treatment programs; and
- 14 (4) Neighborhood restoration.
- 15 The weed and seed strategy works with local law enforcement
- 16 to prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, drug abuse, and
- 17 gang activity in targeted neighborhoods by "weeding" out the
- 18 criminal element in the community. Community policing involves



- 1 having police officers work closely with community residents to
- 2 develop solutions to violent and drug-related crimes. The next
- 3 step is to "seed" the community with human services that include
- 4 prevention, intervention treatment, and neighborhood
- 5 revitalization.
- 6 The legislature finds that the weed and seed strategy has
- 7 been successful since its inception in the Kalihi-Palama and
- 8 Chinatown areas of downtown Honolulu. The legislature further
- 9 finds that since the beginning of the program, crime in those
- 10 areas has been significantly reduced. The legislature further
- 11 finds that the strategy's success warrants its expansion into
- 12 other communities.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 14 weed and seed strategy.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 as a grant
- 18 to the YMCA of Honolulu for the weed and seed strategy.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
