A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 604-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) The chief justice shall appoint district judges to
4	serve on a per diem basis and as may be necessary to provide
5	auxiliary judicial functions in the several districts of the
6	State[-] as follows:
7	(1) The chief justice shall make an appointment from a
8	list of not less than three nominees submitted by the
9	judicial selection commission. Each nominee shall
10	have been an attorney licensed to practice in all
11	courts of the State for at least five years.
12	(2) Per diem district judges shall hold office for a term
13	of two years and until their successors are appointed
14	and qualified; provided that they shall serve no more
15	than three consecutive terms unless, based on the
16	discretion of the chief justice, they are recommended
17	for additional consecutive terms and the

1		recommendation is submitted to the judicial selection
2		commission.
3	(3)	Any per diem district judge may be reprimanded,
4		disciplined, suspended with or without salary,
5		relieved, or removed from office for misconduct or
6		disability, as provided by rules adopted by the
7		supreme court.
8	(4)	Per diem district judges may engage in the private
9		practice of law during their term of service, and
10		shall receive per diem compensation for the days on
11		which actual service is rendered based on the monthly
12		rate of compensation paid to a district court judge.
13		For the purpose of determining per diem compensation
14		in this section, a month shall be deemed to consist of
15		twenty-one days.
16	(5)	If the chief justice intends to reappoint a per diem
17		district judge, the chief justice shall inform the
18		judicial selection commission of that intention three
19		months prior to the expiration of the judge's term,

and the commission shall determine whether the judge

shall be retained."
