SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE GOAL OF ELIMINATING SUFFERING AND DEATH FROM CANCER BY THE YEAR 2015.

WHEREAS, cancer is the second leading cause of death and 1 touches almost every family, with over 10 million Americans now living with a history of cancer; and 3 WHEREAS, cancer affects one out of every four Americans or 5 one out of every two men and one out of every three women; and 6 7 WHEREAS, this year alone, cancer will claim the lives of 8 more than 570,000 Americans or 1,500 people per day; and 9 10 WHEREAS, 1,700 Hawaii residents or roughly one of out every 11 five deaths in Hawaii is attributed to cancer; and 12 13 WHEREAS, more than 1,300,000 cancer cases were diagnosed in 14 2005; and 15 16 WHEREAS, approximately 5,000 men and women in Hawaii are 17 diagnosed each year with the disease; and 18 19 WHEREAS, it is estimated that cancer cost the Nation nearly 20 \$190 billion in 2003, including more than \$69 billion in direct 21 medical costs; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the cost for cancer care in Hawaii is estimated to 24 cost \$500 million each year; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the Nation's investment in cancer research and 27

WHEREAS, between 1991 and 2001, cancer death rates declined

WHEREAS, at least half of all cancer deaths could have been
