The purpose of this bill is to provide an emergency appropriation to improve operations at the Hawaii Youth Correctional Facility for the remaining part of the 2005-2006 fiscal year.

OYS testified that the Governor recommended the immediate passage of this bill, given the serious nature of the findings issued by the Civil Rights Division of the U.S. Department of Justic.
