# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003 established 1 the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii. Act 59 2 directed the department of land and natural resources to 3 preserve the visual, cultural, and historical aspects of the 4 land, and to develop a comprehensive management plan for the 5 6 wilderness area. 7 The purpose of this Act is to extend the length of time allowed to acquire the lands that are designated to become part 8 of the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii. 9 SECTION 2. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, is amended 10 by amending section 4 to read as follows: 11 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2003; 12 provided that: 13 This Act shall be repealed on December 31,  $[2006_{r}]$ 14 (1)2007, if the exchange transactions to acquire the 15 lands described in section 6E-B are not consummated 16
