our Nation as well as our planet and the founding principles which the Preamble of our Constitution states, your Committee agrees that commendation is due for organizations such as the ONE Campaign.


Your Committee also recognizes that our forefathers fought for the right to be free, and the efforts of the ONE Campaign help to guard their dream and legacy.
