begs leave to report as follows:


The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to urge the President of the United States and United States Congress to make a serious commitment to improving the quality of the nation's public schools by:

- (1) Substantially increasing funding to implement the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB), Higher Education Act, Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, and other education-related programs; and
- (2) Creating flexibility in NCLB requirements through mechanisms such as state waivers or exemptions.

The Hawaii State Teachers Association testified in support of this concurrent resolution. The Department of Education supported the intent of this measure. As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Education that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 104 and recommends its adoption.
