"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE HA'IKU ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CAFETERIA BE KNOWN AS THE JEAN SUZUKI CAFETERIA IN HONOR OF FORMER HA'IKU ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CAFETERIA EMPLOYEE JEAN SUZUKI,"

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request Haiku Elementary School to rename its cafeteria the "Jean Suzuki cafeteria" in remembrance and honor of Jean Suzuki, who served as the cafeteria manager at Haiku Elementary School for 36 years.
