Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the Senate to the amendments proposed by the House of Representatives in S.B. No. 2505, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SCHOOL-BASED SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS FOR ADOLESCENTS,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to protect our youth and to prevent alcohol and substance abuse among Hawaii's children by appropriating funds to extend adolescent school-based substance abuse treatment programs to middle and intermediate schools, with priority given to schools with the greatest need.

This measure will enable the continuation of school-based substance abuse treatment programs for adolescents, as well as providing outreach via classroom presentations and networking with teachers and other school personnel. A school may decline an award of funds for school-based substance abuse treatment programs, in

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by changing the effective date to July 1, 2006, by inserting a dollar amount into the blank appropriation, and by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the managers of your Committee on Conference that is attached to this report, your Committee on Conference is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2505, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Final Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2505, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, C.D. 1.
