Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the Senate to the amendments proposed by the House of Representatives in S.B. No. 695, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION AND PRIVACY COMPACT,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to facilitate the interstate exchange of criminal history information for noncriminal justice purposes, including but not limited to background checks for the licensing and screening of employees and volunteers.

The ratification of the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact will enable the State to administer criminal history record checks as well as process background checks in a more expeditious and cost-effective manner. The adoption of the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact will also enable Hawaii to participate in the FBI National Fingerprint File and become a member

on the Compact Council that establishes polices relating to use and exchange of criminal justice data.
